

Fishy, Fishy, in the brook, put your lips upon my hook. Lots of Wishful fisherman out there and we'll try to figure of the best place to go. It appears that a lot of the runs are lagging just a bit behind for some reason. Let's just hope their late and it's not something messing with the runs. Down south fisherman are reporting the Kasilof and Kenai have both been slow but the water levels are improving. Even the Deep Creek saltwater area has been a bit slow but they are picking up Halibut in about 100 feet of water off of the bluffs, some reported in the 50 to 100 pound range. Homer Halibut has been reported fair but there's been some rough seas this past week. The Anchor River, Deep Creek and Ninilchik have another weekend opener and all I can say is lets be hopeful that it picks up. The Russian River opens up June 11 and a few fish have been counted on the sonar so lets hope it shapes up better than the King run. Counts of both are improving daily. Locally it's been slow, there are fish but no real hot areas so far. Ship Creek and the Eklutna Tailrace have both been slow. The Little Su below Burma is slow but improving. I think this is the first report I've ever done that I can't truly say there are any hot spots. The Deshka and Alexander Creek are both producing fish and if the Alexander peaks as it normally does we could be in for a shocker. Lets just hope the fish are on their way and running behind. Anything north of the Deshka on the Big Su is very very slow. Maybe our dipnetters will fare better over on the Chitna. There is an opening from June 9th thru June 11th so you might want to head that direction. The counts over there look better than they do locally and on the peninsula. Valdez is producing some phenomenal catches of halibut basically further out but nice big fish are being taken. It looks like Valdez is working give Homer a run for it's money at the Halibut capital of the world. I think this is the first report I've ever done that I can't truly say there are any real hot spots. Road accessible I'd go for the Little Su down from Burma or Eklutna. Boater's head for Alexander Creek and hope for the best. Dippers take advantage of that first opening of Chitna and Halibut hunters take a jaunt to Valdez.
