Don't fret though you have reds in the Russian Kasilof and the Lower Kenai Rivers. In Anchorage Ship Creek is still producing the mighty Chinook, check your tide book and, oh yeah, Campbell Creek is CLOSED! Apparently some people don't know that. Valdez Halibut is on pace with Homer with a derby leader of 274 pounds and Lingcod fishing also opens July 1st. The Copper, Eyak Coghill even Klutina Rivers are all producing fine reports of reds. Now for the Mat-Su ...if you fish the Alexander River you had better get there now because it closes Saturday night at 11. The Deshka River has really slowed down but I've got hot reports from everywhere else. Honestly pick a place and get there. I really don't think you could go wrong anywhere you go this weekend.
